14-15 YEARS

- Yearly Exam
- Vision Screen
- Hearing Screen
- Labwork If BMI > 95%
- Urine Test - As Needed

16+ YEARS

- Menactra
- Meningitis B (2 Doses)
- Yearly Exam
- Vision Screen
- Hearing Screen
- Labwork If BMI > 95%
- Lipid Screen
- STI Screen - As Needed

VACCINE KEY

- **Hepatitis B:** causes liver disease and cancer
- **DTaP:** Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (whooping cough)
- **Hib:** Hemophilus influenza (causes meningitis)
- **IPV:** Polio
- **Pevnar:** Streptococcus pneumonia (pneumonia, meningitis, sepsis)
- **Rotavirus:** a serious stomach virus (this is an oral vaccine)
- **Hepatitis A:** causes liver disease
- **MMR and Varicella:** Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Chickenpox
- **Tdap:** Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis booster
- **Menactra:** Meningococcal meningitis strains A, C, Y and W135
- **Gardasil:** Human Papilloma Virus (causes multiple forms of cancer)
- **Meningitis B:** Meningococcal meningitis strain B

This is our general schedule, some providers may vary. Flu vaccines are recommended yearly. Other vaccines and precautions may be needed for international travel.

Ask your pediatrician about Our Lady of the Lake Children's Health video visits, extended weekday, and weekend appointments when your child isn't well.
